Respected Enlightened Donors and Kind-hearted friends,

It is indeed a matter of pride and privilege to present before you 16th annual report and share our feelings and ideas with you.

A small initiative of providing primary medical care to rural population in 2005 has now established identity of Sanjivani as a symbol of credibility, transparency, commitment, a symbol of dedication, devotion & passion aided with selfless services of Doctors ,volunteers and support Staff across all projects. Flow of donations all throughout the journey of 16 years has infused energy to team Sanjivani to take up different tasks for upliftment of society.

As you all know, the period after March 2020 till date had been a nightmare for entire world including India which suffered deadly CORONA virus pandemic. The first wave of 2020 was comparatively less leathel than the second wave of 2021. All industries, small businesses, retail business and activities of NGOs was badly affected during this period. Nation faced huge lively loss across almost all states. All private hospitals, Trust based hospitals and clinics were closed and government had tried utmost to face the challenge. Glittering line amongst dark clouds of COVID was initiative of government "Atmanirbhar Bharat" under which our pharma sector and research organisation developed economical, effective vaccine against COVID. Till today, India has broken world record of giving highest number of vaccines to our population and has been largest exporter of vaccine to support countries across the world.

Over the years since inception, sanjivani has coined various activities from Health Care-to Education-to Women Empowerment-to skill development-to Relief Activity during pandemic of COVID-19.

Rural Health Program:

During the Covid-19 Pandemic all Rural Health activities were paralysed, as initially the movements were restricted due to lockdown and later as Senior Family Physicians going to villages have withdrawn due to age factor, Family restraints, daily tiresome travelling and possible risk of getting COVID-19 infection looking to their age. We are highly thankful to all doctors who have given services all these years.

It was only after 5th July 2020 we restarted Rural Camps by starting 1st van and by August added 2nd van after obtaining prior permission from CDHO –Kheda and Ahmedabad, and undertaking from Rural stack holders about maintaining strict social distancing and asking beneficiaries to use Mask.

• Urban Sanjivani Clinic – sponsored by Late. Smt. Madhuben J. Patel (Nagar Parivar) operates daily between 2.00 to 5.00 providing same facilities to poor patients like, Gramin Arogya Kendra ,Just for a break of 1 week in COVID 19 Pandemic we restarted this clinic and daily 20-25 patients are taking benefit.

Sanjivani Health Care Centre

A fully equipped O.P.D. based diagnostic centre in name of **Shantaben Shatilal Kothari (Jewelex India Mumbai)-** Sanjivani Health Care Centre at present on an average 150 to 200 patients are getting facility of investigations, medical advice and benefit of generic medical store.

Our **Generic medical store** is providing medicines at most economical rate which



poorest of poor can afford.

Sadhu saints of all religion are provided free services at the centre. During the deadly second wave of CORONA in 2021 our trust saw that the deadly virus was affecting entire family leading to exorbitant cost for basic investigations and treatment even at our charitable rate.

On 05-05-2021, we started giving 50% discount on all investigations and medicines from our stores to CORONA patients.

Similarly, the need of CT scan of the chest **(HRCT)** which was again cost prohibitive for average income group. We tied up with two reputed CT scan centre and offered CT scan facility to needy patients recommended by our doctor at just token Rs. 500/- charge, balance amount was paid by Sanjivani.

The third major constraint in treatment of CORONA patient was availability of oxygen and pulse oximeter. Oxymeters, good quality masks and oxygen concentrator machines were selling at very high rate in market with short supply. We took the decision of providing N95 masks at Rs. 10/-. Pulse oximeter at Rs. 600/- and oxygen concentrator machines at fully refundable deposit of Rs. 2500/-. Even today this service is given to needy post-covid patients and patients having cardiac, lungs or kidney problems needing oxygen therapy.

All these has been possible with generous financial support from wide spectrum of society. We are sincerely thankful to all the donors who have supported us in fighting CORONA pandemic. In less than just a month, we had 58 oxygen concentrator machines under name of Sanjivani oxygen bank.

Smt. ChandrabenPiyushbhai Kothari (Jewelex) sponsored Sanjivani Dialysis centre

Our intension was to start dialysis centre in our premises with five machines before March 2021 but again the deadly CORONA pandemic prevented us to postpone the project till July. We are highly thankful to Jewelex foundation, Mumbai to support financially for this project. From 12th July, 2021 on auspicious day of Rathyatra, this was inaugurated with all necessary permissions from respective authorities.

"SanjivaniSuraksha" Sanitary Napkin Project:

Due to restrictions laid down by CDHO and Gram Panchayat at grass root level, no vans were allowed to enter the villages to prevent community spread. So it was only after July, one van for sanitary pad was started but the financial constraints

Restricted the number of beneficiaries. As a result we had to stop the production and restrict distribution of sanitary pads.

Women empowerment Skill development courses:

As we started Sanjivani Dialysis centre, we were in need of separate premises for skill development courses for girls. Fortunately, one donor family donated their house near our centre free of cost for use to established our courses. We renovated the entire building with their financial support and started RR Chandiramani sponsored Sanjivani Women Empowerment Centre at 3,Sundarvan Soc., B/h Jawaharnagar, Paldi, Ahmedabad-07. At present, 6thbatch of coaching classes are in progress. At the end of three months course, formal examination assessment is done and are issued certificates. We are happy to inform you all that nearly 40 to 50% girls have started earning and supporting their family financially by starting business activity. We started in February 2021 intermittently following COVID guidelines laid down by government time to time.

courses like-

- Beauty Parlour
- Mehdi Designs
- Tailoring
- Basic Computer courses
- Yog classes for ladies
- Self defence training for girls (Taekwondo-Korean Karate)

Around 170 to 180 women and girls are taking benefit of these activities at present.

This project was handled successfully by our project Co ordinators -Smt. SmitabenThaker and Atulbhai Patel and monitored by Shri Dineshbhai Dhanadhara and Shri Kiranbhai Shah.

During entire year 2020-21, schools were closed due to COVID pandemic, so, offline class education was not possible. Since majority of the students do not have smart phones or online education facilities, we decided to prepare comprehensive worksheets for all subjects chapterwise, got it typed-copied and parents were called to collect the same the class wise. At the end of every fortnight, offline exams were taken, sending papers through parents followed by evaluating the progress of students. For KG students, we had given mobile phones to teachers to be in contact with each student at least once a week, telling stories to keep them engaged with school.

Last year even before government, education department ordered 25% reduction in fees, we already had given 50% discount in fees looking to financial condition of parents, 90% + belong to economically weaker class.

Various activities like-

- Sweet packets distribution to all students In Diwali-09-11-2020
- Sweaters and chikki packets were distributed on 18-12-2020
- Khajur (dates) packets to all students on 12-01-2021
- Peanuts and chickpeas distribution on 12-03-2021
- Grocery kits distribution- in the first round 12KGs grocery kit to all students family. Then we performed door to door economical survey of all student families and in second and third round, we distributed 450+ grocery kits to needy families.
- For all offline education activity, worksheets, papers and exercise books were given free to all students.

Sessions for Teachers Training and motivational sessions.

To enhance the capability of teachers, various inter-active seminars were conducted amongst teachers. Motivational lectures were also conducted to remove fear of CORONA and how to be positive and think positive for self and students, because we know that after a long gap of one and half year, most of the students will be blank. So, they will have again have to start with basic reading, writing and counting skill.

Our trust decided to waive off three months fees for September, August, October-2022 for students taking admission in KG section.

As we have done earlier, this year also we have started providing one pair of uniform this month to students of standard 6 to 10 free of cost with support of donors. Notebooks and exercise books were also provided free and support education material at 50% discount to students to provide quality education without financial burden on parents.

Evening Learning Center project (ELC-Massom): Last year, with the support of "Masoom" organization of Mumbai, we started an Evening Learning Centre for those unfortunate students who had left study due to any reason. Of 46 students enrolled under bridge course, 36 students started attending evening school and during the COVID-19 shutdown phase also are continuing online coaching and were doing well. Our School



has been the first ELC school of Gujarat. This batch scored 25% result in spite of non-continuity of classroom teaching against overall 10% result of Gujarat Board. This year nearly 110 students have been enrolled, of which 70 to 80 students are regularly attending the evening class.

Activities for CORONA warriors like, fire brigade and traffic police staff: Detection camps for Hypertension and Diabetes were carried out at different spots of traffic points and Police staff during the lockdown and we also gave donation of RS. 25000/- to benevolent fund of fire brigade staff as an appreciation of their services during COVID-19 pandemic and this year we motivated one donor to donate 1,11,111/- in benevolent fund of fire brigade.

During the pandemic, we did on site checking of BP and Diabetes for CORONA warriors (traffic police) on the spot where they were posted.

Our appeal is to donate time, skill, wisdom, experience, intelligence and money for upliftment of society and make India a just country with equality, opportunity for all.

કોરોના કાળમાં શાળાકીય શિક્ષણ લગભગ બંધ જ હતુ અને બાળકો પાસે ઓનલાઈન અભ્યાસ માટે યોગ્ય સુવિધા ન હોઈ તમામ બાળકો માટે વિષયવાર અધ્યયન સામગ્રી તૈયાર કરાવી વાલીગણ મારફતે તમામ વિદ્યાર્થીઓ સુધી પહોંચાડી તેઓને શિક્ષણ સાથે સાંકળી રાખવામાં આવ્યા હતા.

વર્ષ ૨૦૨૧-૨૨માં આર્થિક સંકડામણને કારણે તથા પ્રાથમિક શાળા ચાલુ ન હોવાથી ઘણા વાલી પોતાના બાળકોને શિક્ષણથી વંચિત કરી રહ્યા હતા જે જોઈ ટ્રસ્ટી મંડળ દ્વારા સત્વરે નિર્ણય લઈ ઑગસ્ટ, સપ્ટેમ્બર, ઓક્ટોબર-૨૦૨૧ની સંપૂર્ણ ફી માફી આપવાનો નિર્ણય કરવામાં આવ્યો હતો. હાલમાં શાળામાં ૯૮૬ બાળકો પ્રત્યક્ષ કે પરોક્ષ રીતે શિક્ષણ મેળવી રહ્યા છે.
