

From Desk of President



I am extremely delighted to present before you 11th Annual Report of Sanjivani Health and Relief Committee “SHRC”.

As you all know Sanjivani took birth from Small initiative of helping flood affected villages of Kheda District in 2005, got momentum year after year and with blessing of donors from wide spectrum of society, Dedication, commitment & tireless work of hundreds of Doctors & volunteers, has now been able to fulfill all dreams and desires to help underserved corner part of society in remote villages.

We at Sanjivani have observed that to day our nation has two distinct faces. One being that of development, rapid economic growth, technological development which is seen across all cities of nation and other face unfortunately is that of 60 to 70% nation still living in 19th century. with poor state of health care & educational development. Gap between affluent 20% community & 80% poor community is increasing to an alarming level. Rapid growth & urbanization has given birth to miles of unorganized - unhygienic slums around all cities. Job opportunities are limited to cities only leading to migration of illiterate villagers in search of job to cities, compelling them to stay in huts & colonies with poor sanitation, infrastructure, ventilation, leading to rise in both communicable & non communicable diseases. Majority of people has to travel miles for job leading to faulty diet - habits, stress, inadequate sleep - all giving birth to diseases like Hypertension, Diabetes, Heart - and kidney diseases over and above decades old enemies like dengue, malaria, skin disease & Tuberculosis.

Still to day majority of villages lack basic right to quality education and qualified primary health facility.

Literate - affluent class running fast in search of prosperity has left behind basic human values of kindness, love & justice to others & in this run loses peace of mind and life. Has left behind core cultural values like truth, and nonviolence and has lost moral. Adding to these, present cultural - political scenario money power and muscle power has replaced intelligence and wisdom leading to wide spread incidences of violence, sexual abuse & addiction. We believe that bureaucracy and corruption has made good Government policies ineffective. Benefit to end were hardly percolates to last mile. In these situation good, and transparent NGO's and kind donor community has to play a vital role of bridging the gap in providing basic health & education services.

The work initiated and executed by our team Sanjivani is just a beginning & has miles to go, Our efforts in creation of clean, healthy, educated nation ably supported by continuous flow of funds from donors from wide spectrum of society has made all programs launched by Sanjivani to be useful to society and be successful. We expect similar or even enhanced support from all of you in coming years to make all projects lasting, sustainable & replicable. This year we have added two more value added services to our armamentarium

Mobile Pathology Laboratory -

This is done for the first time by any NGO in Gujarat in mobile medical setup. With generous donation from **Smt. Kokilaben Manubhai Patel** we launched this last year. In this all basic biochemistry reports are made available to underserved community at most affordable (Token) rates.

Sanjivani Suraksha Initiative - A Sanitary Napkin Project

Mission

- To promote installing multiple projects across weaker section of society with help of like-minded NGOs and organizations to manufacture and promote use of sanitary napkins amongst underprivileged ladies in child bearing age groups.
- To generate jobs for them under cottage industry model and at the same time, promote their earning through distribution network in future.

Sanjivani Health Care Centre (fully equipped OPD based Diagnostic Centre)

In April 15, SHRC with generous financial support from Jewalex India - Group Bombay Sanjivani started this fully equipped OPD based Diagnostic centre in Ahmedabad named.

Smt. Shantaben Shantilal Kothari Pariwar Sanjivani Health Care Centre.

The Group provided a building owned by their firm Sparkling Gems, and funds to develop it into modern diagnostic centre.

Here 42 consultant Doctors from various faculties provide their services to needy underprivileged population who cannot afford to avail services from private setup.

As you all know started in a modest way in 2005, SHRC today has a team of 75+ medical personnel and 200+ volunteers and 12 mobile medical vans, including one Mobile Dental Van, one Mobile Ophthalmic Van and two mobile Telemedicine Vans with ECG facility. First of all we sincerely thank all the donors for their generous support all these years- especially principal donors with whose support we have travelled eleven years in health care and education service. We sincerely thank all well-wishers and advisory board members who have given valuable suggestions in implementation and improvisation of our services. What Sanjivani is today is surely due to the help from all of you as well as Doctors, volunteers and part time employees.

Focused Areas

SHRC is working on three of the most critical and thrust areas, which are unfortunately, poorly addressed in the current socio-political scenario of the country.

- Sanjivani Healthcare Initiative – **Rural and Urban**
- Sanjivani Education Initiative
- Sanjivani Suraksha –A Sanitary napkin Project

Sanjivani Healthcare Initiative -

Mission

- To provide accessible, affordable and qualified basic healthcare services to small villages through mobile medical clinics.
- To spread awareness about healthy, addiction-free living
- To prevent, detect and treat diabetes and hypertension in early stages
- To empower women through skill development and to generate job for them. We have been focusing on this since inception and all our projects employ maximum number of females, and we have been successfully managing all projects at the same in bringing out skill and intelligence of female staff for service of the society.

A. Rural Primary Health care facility-

- Rural Health-Mobile Medical Clinics–Sanjivani Arogya Kendra

- Sanjivani Urban Medical Clinic
- Project Hypertension and Diabetes

Mobile Medical Clinics -

- ✿ Currently Sanjivani provides free medical treatment to 300 + grass root villages of Kheda, Ahmedabad, and Gandhinagar districts.
- ✿ Sanjivani covers 12 villages on daily basis, throughout the year, with fortnightly follow up.
- ✿ Ophthalmic and Dental Van operates on Sundays.
- ✿ 2 Tele Medicine Vans provide value added ECG service to 2 villages daily.
- ✿ Mobile Pathology Laboratory, providing basic biochemistry tests at just token rates, is recently launched.
- ✿ On an average 13,000 patients get treatment per month

Project Hypertension and Diabetes

Objective

To create awareness, early detection and treatment to prevent need for hospitalization and to save preventable expenditure and prevention of associated complications amongst rural and urban poor population. We are focussing on.

Awareness

Distribution of literature in local language at daily & weekly medical camps for creating awareness on diabetes and Hypertension.

- Mass education program to cover large gatherings at temples and various organisations, gardens, clubs etc. to create mass awareness about chronic NCD (Non Communicable Diseases), especially diabetes.
- Audio Visual presentation for awareness of Diabetes in Fasting Blood Sugar.
- People with serious heart problems get ECG in village itself in SHRC Telemedicine Van. Immediate treatment plan saves from possible fatality. People with evidence of target organ damage are provided detailed investigational facility by specialists.
- The project is managed by qualified doctors in medical camps and detailed investigation is done in a well-equipped base hospital.

Services of telemedicine van with ECG and mobile pathology laboratory are provided daily an different villages.

Project Hypertension – Diabetes

Our focus has been middle income group population across villages under our service as well as urban outskirts slums. We intend to raise awareness about non communicable diseases like Hypertension, Diabetes, heart and kidney diseases by generating mass awareness about life style, diet, exercise, stress management, early detection and early initiation of treatment.

Sanjivani Arogya Kendra – Urban

With the generous donation from **Nagar Chashmaghar Pariwar** - In memory of Smt. **Madhuben Jayantilal Patel**-this centre was started in 2011. Since then it has been providing primary health care facility to urban poor community. At present average 40 patients take benefit daily.

All these achievement have been possible with tremendous trust and financial support from our sympathetic and empathetic donors from wide spectrum of society ranging from small individual one to business houses and corporates from India and abroad.

This year we added two more services under health care initiative namely-

“Sanjivani Suraksha” – Sanitary Napkin Project

With generous donation from S M Nanavati Charitable Trust – Ahmedabad we started this project in January 2016 in small scale cottage industry model. We trained girls from weaker section of society to manufacture quality sanitary pads from varginnon irritant materials. And started distributing in villages under our service, to ApangManavMandal ,Manthan (Hajipur) etc. free of cost. We are happy to inform you that till date we have distributed more than 1,25,000 pads. This initiative has been useful in providing them clean, hygienic and healthy life style.

Mobile Pathology Laboratory Project

With financial support from Smt. KokilabenManubhai Patel we started this project in March 2016. Under this project a high-tech micro laboratory model provide all basic bio- chemistry report like –

- Lipid Profile
- Kidney Function test
- Liver function test
- Uric Acid
- Hemoglobin
- Blood Sugar



Under this project without asking the patient to go to laboratory, to give blood, collect report etc. reports are processed and provided in the same camp along with necessary treatment and guidance by our medical team. This is for the first time in Gujarat for any NGO

Sanjivani Health Care Centre -A secondary referral Centre for Advanced Health Care

In April 2015, Sanjivani added one more feather in its cap by name of Sanjivani Health Care Centre with huge donation from JewelexIndia family , Bombay. This centre has been unique providing all diagnostic facilities under one roof for middle income and low income community. The uniqueness of the center is in providing services like lifestyle modification, Yoga, social counselling free of cost. This center provides free diagnosis and treatment to all Sadhu Sant. As an initiative of providing preventive services for Hypertention and Diabetes any patients can avail all diagnostic service at just token rate.

Facilities provided at this centre are-

- Juvenile Diabetes Clinic
- Physiotherapy Center
- Dental Clinic
- Yoga Center –Social Counselling Center
- Generic Medical Store
- Fully equipped Cardiac workup facility
- Modern Pathology Laboratory Relief Committee
- All speciality consultants services including, physician, Surgeon, Gynaecologist, skin, ophthalmic, paediatric, psychiatry, dietician etc.

Project Juvenile Diabetes at Sanjivani

- Under this project we support such poor patients of type-1 diabetes for adequate medication, periodic investigation and educating them for self monitoring.
- The centre is unique to provide free insulin, insulin pen, cartridge and needle to all poor patients at token charges, since insulin has to be taken twice/ thrice a day lifelong.
- Besides that, we giveself monitoring blood glucose (SMBG) kit to each patient so that the patient can himself check blood sugar level.

Sanjivani Physiotherapy Centre -

- Sanjivani believes that Physiotherapy centres and fitness centres for elderly should be made available wherein a patient can get qualified service at most affordable rates.

- A centre where a patient can get all therapy including teaching and counselling for life style modification, weight management, yoga training, acupressure treatment, positive thinking and holistic approach of using their skill, wisdom, energy and time for upliftment of society with a concept of giving back to society, over and above physiotherapy.
- Center also serve as referral centre for 300+ villages under SHRC service coverage area.

Sanjivani Dental Clinic -

- SHRC Dental Van provides tooth extraction, filling and scaling facility to these patient at their doorstep.
- Since it is not possible to provide denture or root canal treatment in single sitting, our dental clinic at this centre serve as referral centre for such patients, where all advanced dental procedures are provided at most affordable rates.

Sanjivani Generic Medical Store -

- Ever rising cost of medicines leads to heavy burden on poor patients. This results into poor compliance to treatment, which is one of the major challenges to cure.
- If medicines for Hypertension, Diabetes or Heart Diseases are made available to patients at affordable rates overall out come will improve.
- At our centre patients get medicines at 75-80% discounted cost, as compared to MRP.

As you know journey started in 2012 with an attempt to provide free support education (Free Tution Classes). The success of this initiative motivated us to have our own School to develop a model school where poorest of poor child can avail quality education in state of art, technology enriched infrastructure at most affordable rates. In present scenario education at good school has been only a privilege for affluent class of families, children from weaker section of society can hardly dream for the same.

Our Vision-has been **Right to Education**

Mission

- To make available quality education which is accessible, affordable and within reach of children from economically weaker section of society.
- To provide application-oriented and value-added education with thrust on human values, cultural values, skill development and personality development without adding any financial burden on parents.

Objective-

Sanjivani Education Initiative

- ✿ **Sanjivani SanskarDham**-Starting with 40 students in std 1 to 4 in year 2012, presently about 180 students of std 1 to 9 are provided supportive education from make-shift class rooms in SSD School.
- ✿ **Shiv Prathamik & Madhyamik Shala**-From June 2014, SHRC have taken over one school, Shiv PrathamikShala, in Vasna Area of Ahmedabad, where at present 629+ children from really economically weaker section of society take benefit at most affordable rates from pre-primary to Std 9 in Gujarati medium.
- ✿ **Sanjivani Vidyavihar**-SHRC have also have started Sanjivani Vidyavihar, an English medium primary school from June 2014 and at present 114+ children from really economically weaker section of society take benefit of this facility.

✿ **No Fine Prints!**

- ✿ At SHRC Education Initiative, there are no hidden fees or extra charges for events, festival celebrations or educational tours. All support education materials and exercise books are provided free of cost. Nutrition and healthcare are also well cared.
- ✿ Special feature of this school is that poor children are given 100% freship, only they have to pay term fees.
- ✿ Students getting more than 50% marks in all written exams are given 100 % scholarship to develop competitiveness amongst them.
- ✿ Almost 30 % of students avail either of above aid.
- ✿ 95% students of the school hail from reserved category population.
- ✿ 50% of students are girls which again is a strong indicative in direction of female empowerment.

With received generous support from **GRUH Finance Co Ltd- Ahmedabad for this** project. With their support we have been able to provide safe drinking water project with R.O.Plant, watercoolers, water room hyegenic toilet blocks for girls and boys etc. We have been providing nutritious high protein snacks daily free of cost to students since 2015-16 with financial support from GRUH. The nutritious snacks are prepared as per presence of students on day to day basis at school it self.

Focus on cultural-Spiritual-skill development-

At our school all events and festivals are celebrated without any financial burdon on parents. During the past year following activities were carried out-

- Guru-Purnima Celebration
- Falicitation of sutdents becoming eligible for scholarship
- Celebration of 15th August and 26th Jan in presence of dignitaries from different fields
- Janmastmi-and Krishnajanma celebration
- Christmas Celebration-with funfair and various rides for them
- Participation in Krishna Heritage Quest-Students took part in different event competition arranged by Here Krishna Foundation and they won 27 prizes in different events.
- Free medical camp not only for students but for their entire families by Sanjivani, Special dental checkup and eye checkup camps were arranged for students.

- Yog training-shriVinodbhai Thaker arranged for a program Ramta Ramta yog Shikho. Yog guru Shri Dushyantbhai Modi from M.S.Uni. Baroda took the session,which was attended by all students.
- Science fair competition-our student took part and won 2nd prise in Ahmedabad for Solar Project.
- Navratri Celebration
- Rangoli competition
- Quize competition
- Educational tour to Taranga Hills-with support of Social Forestry Department of Gandhinagar this tour became really educational one. Students took benefit of tracking and gained insight to beauty of nature and forest. Also they understood importance of preservance of environment.

From current year 2016-17 with generous donation from **Jewelex Group-Mumbai** and from **Shri Lalji Mehrotra Charitable Trust - Mumbai**, we could renovate the entire school building.Created best infrastructure,enriched with technology and implemented a novel education program called BIL-blended interactive learning.We have created a computer lab with 51 P.C. linked to a server room,4 smart classes with audio visual presentation facility. **Shri Jitubhai Shah** from Germany donated for software support for 3-5 years.Now each student will learn the subject with graphics, animations, practicals and logic to make education more meaningful and application oriented.Each student will have minimum one hour onhand revision on P.C.We have started getting good response from students also in their performance too.

Now the entire complex is named after Shri **Pravinbhai Shantilal Kothari Parivar-Jewelex India-Mumbai**.

Our team is very well aware about preservance of cultural , moral and spiritual heritage of our nation and are committed to fulfil the dream of providind quality education to all without financial burdon on parents.
